raised in richmond, va., edmund eugene mullins attended nyu where he received a bfa in film studies. after working for a year as an editor for abc news in new york, he went on to receive his ma in literature from northwestern university. in 1999, he moved to buenos aires, argentina, where he worked both as a journalist for the associated press and as a professor of english at lincoln university college.

returning to new york in 2001, mullins continued to work as a freelance journalist, writing for such publications as films in review, the village voice, revolver, and hustler. he also wrote and directed episodes of the serial television program, hook-ups, for the showtime network.

at present, mullins lives in brooklyn and serves as the senior film critic for blackbook magazine he has completed two feature-length screenplays, citizen candy and ride like hell, and a novel, the sting and the honey. he is currently at work on a new script.
